## **Clover Hill Park Recognized**

As one of the newest services that FSA offers, the Environmental Division takes pride in meeting or exceeding environmental standards. From water quality management and stream restoration to LEED certified projects, the Environmental Division works with regulatory agencies and offers environmentally sound solutions to each client and project. Recently, the Environmental Division at FSA was recognized in the Frederick News-Post for its part in a stream restoration project in the Clover Hill residential community near Frederick, MD.

FSA worked with the Potomac Conservancy and the Clover Hill Civic Association to provide a functional stream channel with riffles, runs, pools, and glides. Project design was based on reference channel topography and implementing fluvial geomorphologic principles. The construction phase was started and completed during May 2012 within 10 days.
